**EPISTLE: ROMANS 15:1-7**

**GOSPEL: MATTHEW 9:27-35**

When he had gone indoors, the blind men came to him, and he asked them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" "Yes, Lord," they replied. But they went out and spread the news about him all over that region. While they were going out, a man who was demon-possessed and could not talk was brought to Jesus.
